## Trade Fairs and Exhibitions

Halls B to F, each 10,000 square meters in area, can be used individually or connected together to create a maximum exhibition space of 50,000 square meters. Halls can also be used with conference rooms for seminars, meetings, business negotiations, etc., associated with exhibitions, and the multipurpose area can be used for outdoor exhibits, expansion of the carry-in space and so on.

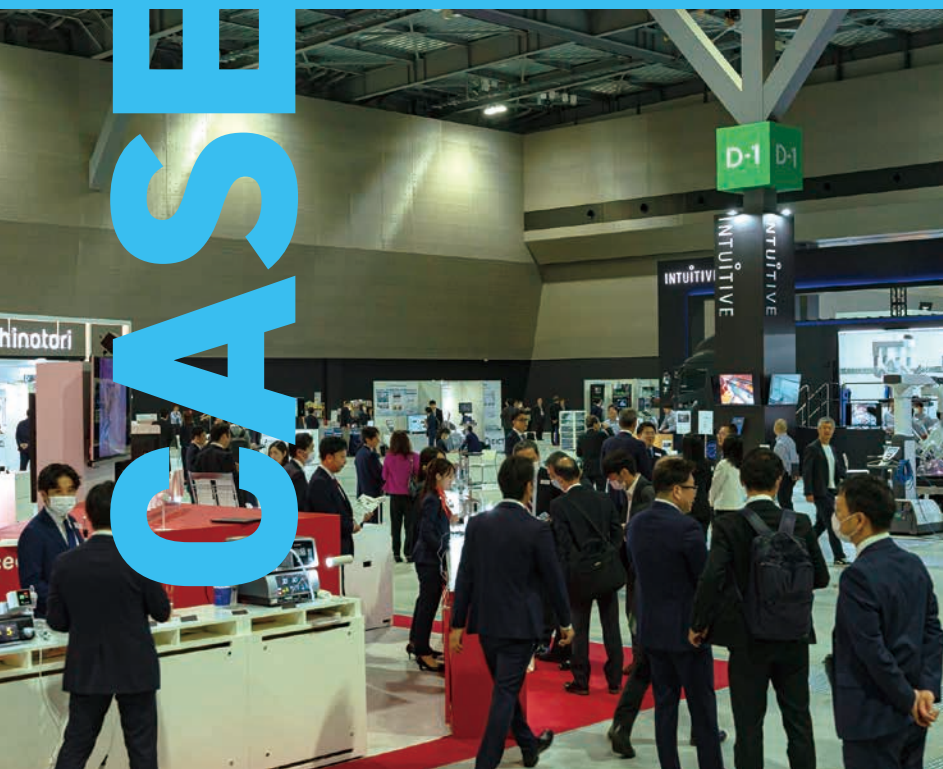

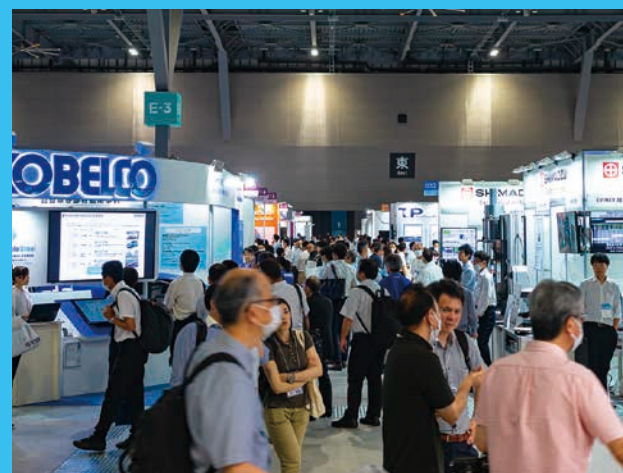

## Concerts & Festivals

Hall A features a column-free space with a high ceiling 20 meters above the floor, which is ideal for concerts. In addition, large-scale outdoor festivals can be held at the multipurpose area which is approximately 36,000 square meters in area (outdoors). Halls B to F can be connected to organize an event in a unified manner.

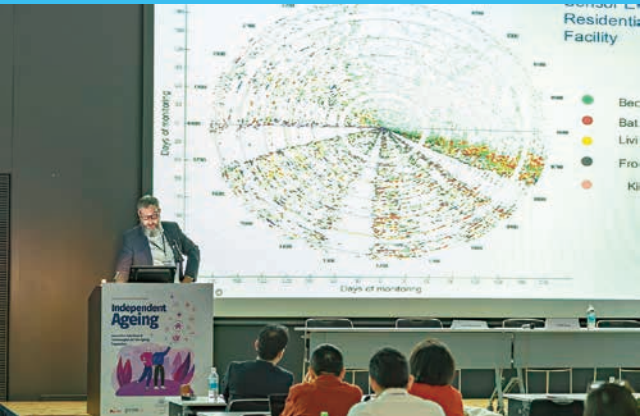

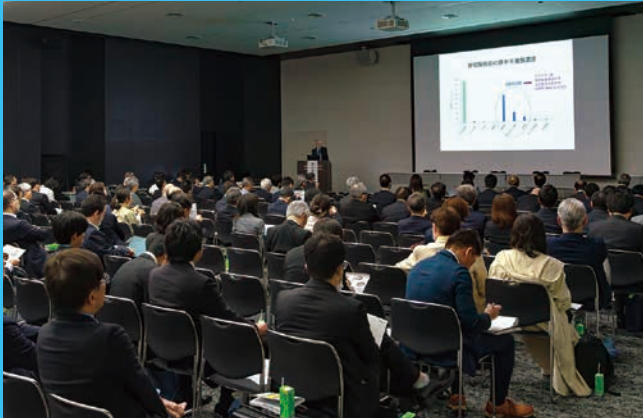

# Corporate Events and Social Gatherings

Exhibition halls and conference rooms are suitable for welcome parties for new employees, corporate anniversary events, and social gatherings. In addition, Aichi Sky Expo is equipped with full-scale kitchen facilities, which is rare for a large-scale exhibition center, and can provide freshly cooked dishes by chefs on site in addition to catering services.

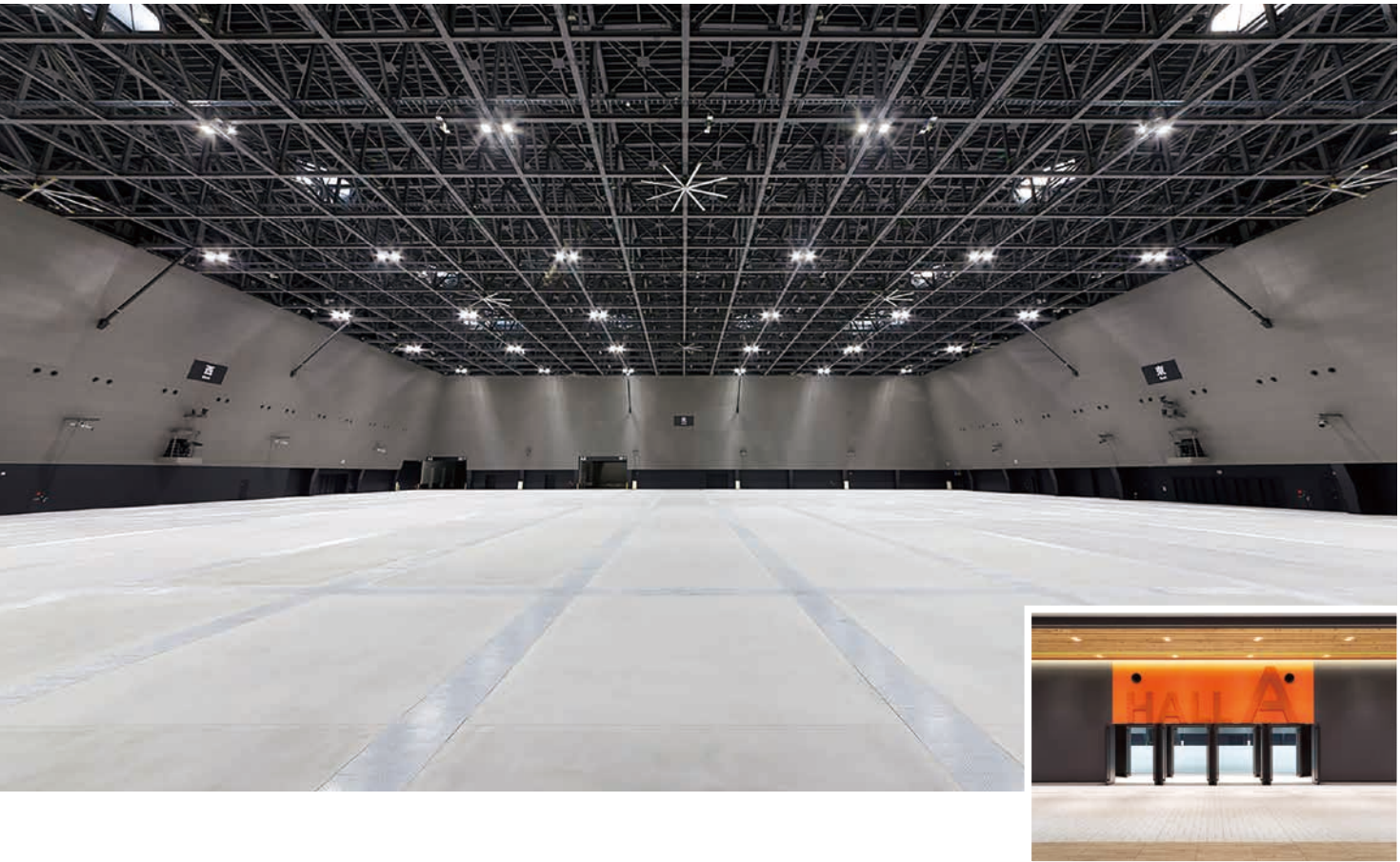
## Exhibition Halls

Hall A is a non-pillar space that is often used as a concert venue. Halls B, C, D, E, and F are connectable. Not only exhibitions and trade fairs, but also e-sports competitions, sports events, academic conferences, and corporate events can be held.

Hall A, column-free space with a high ceiling 20 meters above the floor

Up to 50,000 square meters (when connecting halls B to F)

Six halls in total



## Conference Rooms

In addition to academic conferences, meetings, corporate events, social gatherings, etc., conference rooms can also be used as a waiting room for event staff along with the use of the hall.

30 to 800 square meters in area

18 rooms in total (large, medium and small)

Up to 400 people



## Multipurpose area

The multipurpose area is often used for outdoor events, festivals, automobile/motorcycle-related events including shooting commercials. It can also be used to expand the carry-in space.

About 36,000 square meters in area

Four lots in total



## Kitchen facilities

Equipped with full-scale kitchen facilities, which is rare for a large event venue, we can provide a higher level of food and beverage service including cooking by chefs. In addition to cooking by our dedicated event chefs, we offer safe and reliable kitchen facilities for dishes that are difficult to prepare in the exhibitor booths or for food preparation at food events.

## First-ever exhibition center achieving CASBEE S rating and ZEB Ready

CASBEE (Comprehensive Assessment System for Built Environment Efficiency) is an evaluation and rating system for the environmental performance of buildings. Aichi Sky Expo has received an S rating, the highest of its kind. ZEB stands for Net Zero Energy Building, and refers to a building in which annual primary energy consumption is significantly reduced compared to a building of the same size with standard facility specifications, through energy conservation efforts using high-efficiency equipment while maintaining a comfortable indoor environment. Aichi Sky Expo has acquired the ZEB Ready certification, which is given to buildings that reduce annual primary energy consumption by 50% or more. In addition, the entrance large eaves are equipped with a wall greening system, Vertical Forest®, to visualize the environmental design.



## Warm and inviting design made with Aichi Prefecture's local products

Aichi Prefecture has long been famous for the lumber produced from its rich forests and a variety of pottery. Aichi Sky Expo's entrance hall and malls use lots of local products to create comfortable space. Aichi certified lumber, Obara Japanese paper, Seto bricks and porcelain tiles produced in Tokoname are used.



## Regional Revitalization SDGs

Under the theme of regional revitalization, the Aichi Sky Expo analyzes issues unique to local communities from the perspectives of society, economy, and environment. In addition, the Aichi Sky Expo utilizes the characteristics of the exhibition center as a “hub of information” to develop a mechanism to solve these issues and grow together with local communities.



Projects that collaborate with local communities and communicate to society **MADE IN AICHI** - The strength of Tokoname, the strength of Aichi-

- Agriculture** Local vegetables, rice and sausages are used in dishes served at the food court to promote local food brands.
- Industry** Acting as an intermediary between the organizers and local institutions, we create opportunities for local industries to become better known through the event.
- Commerce** Actively employing local companies as subcontractors for us creates opportunities for event organizers to learn about the services provided by the local companies.

## Projects responsible for local economy

- 100% clean energy** Based on the social responsibility that exhibition centers use more electricity than other types of facilities, we have achieved the use of clean electricity for facility use. While partly using solar power (surplus power is sold), the main power is provided by clean energy (Aichi Green Power). By using this power as clean energy for local circulation, we are working together with local businesses to reduce our CO<sub>2</sub> emissions and achieve local production for the local consumption of renewable energy and local economic circulation.
- Creating an Environment for Environmentally Friendly Events** We propose to event organizers to hold events that utilize carbon offsets, and we also disclose to the organizers the energy consumption of event venues necessary for the calculation of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions. In order for the entire event industry to remain a sustainable industry, we have created an environment where you can hold “net zero carbon events” that virtually eliminate greenhouse gas emissions.
- Consideration for the surrounding area** Surrounded by the sea, Aichi Sky Expo places particular emphasis on initiatives related to marine pollution control. In cleaning, we reduce the use of surfactants, which are difficult to decompose in rivers and the sea, and mainly use alkaline ionized water, which does not contain chemicals or environmental pollutants. In addition, as a countermeasure against littering into the bay from outdoor events, we regularly pick up litter in the surrounding area.



Gourmet



BAR & BISTRO KYOUEI-GAMA

The Kyouei Kiln, which was used to bake clay pipes during the Meiji, Taisho, and Showa eras, has been renovated and now is operated as a bar and bistro that is unique to the pottery production area where you can see the remaining original kiln structure. Easily accessible from the Tokoname Station.



Okura Mochi

This shop specializes in rice cakes made with rich ingredients from the Chita Peninsula. It passes down the “rice cake sweets culture” nurtured by the pottery culture. The “Toilet Monaka,” a collaboration with the LIXIL Enokido Plant, is a popular souvenir.



Centrair Restaurants

More than 50 restaurants offer a wide variety of meals, including “Nagoya meshi” (Nagoya gourmet). The area of restaurants is directly connected to Aichi Sky Expo, so it is easily accessible.



Sunset Walker Hill

A coastal restaurant, Sunset Walker Hill, on the Chita Peninsula offers a spectacular view of Ise Bay. Enjoy wine made in Tokoname at the winery restaurant on the hill. Transportation by bus is available. (Ask about the transportation service in advance)



GOURMET GUIDE



Sawada Sake Brewery



Sake is brewed in the cold wind named Ibukioroshi, using the old traditional method. Taking advantage of the climate and water unique to this region, they continue to make sake that is close to the daily life of the Chita Peninsula. Sake brewery tours and tasting are available.

INAX Tile Museum is a popular photo spot. In addition, visitors can enjoy a wide variety of hands-on activities such as tile art (reservations required) and a restaurant where pizza baked in a wood-fired oven is popular.

Rinku Beach

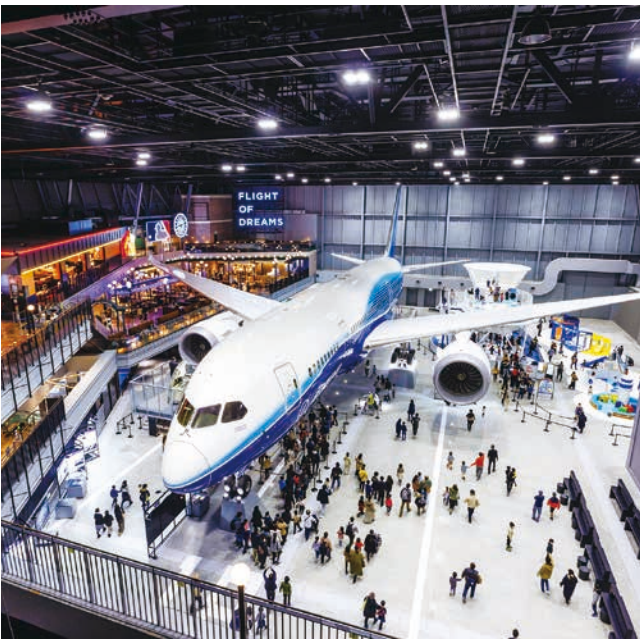
An artificial beach on the opposite shore of Centrair. You can see airplanes taking off and landing at the airport against the backdrop of the sun setting over the sea. It is scenery which you can only see here. The beach is close to Aeon Mall, so you can enjoy shopping as well.

Tokoname Pottery Path

Tokoname, a pottery town with a history of one thousand years, has a unique townscape with pottery shards embedded in the road surface and a slope called “Dokanzaka” where clay pipes are arranged.



Flight of Dreams

This is a commercial complex located in Terminal 2 of Chubu Centrair International Airport that mainly exhibits the first Boeing 787. There is “Flight Park,” where visitors can learn about aviation and airports and play on a variety of playground equipment, and “Seattle Terrace,” a dining area themed on Seattle, the city where Boeing was founded.
